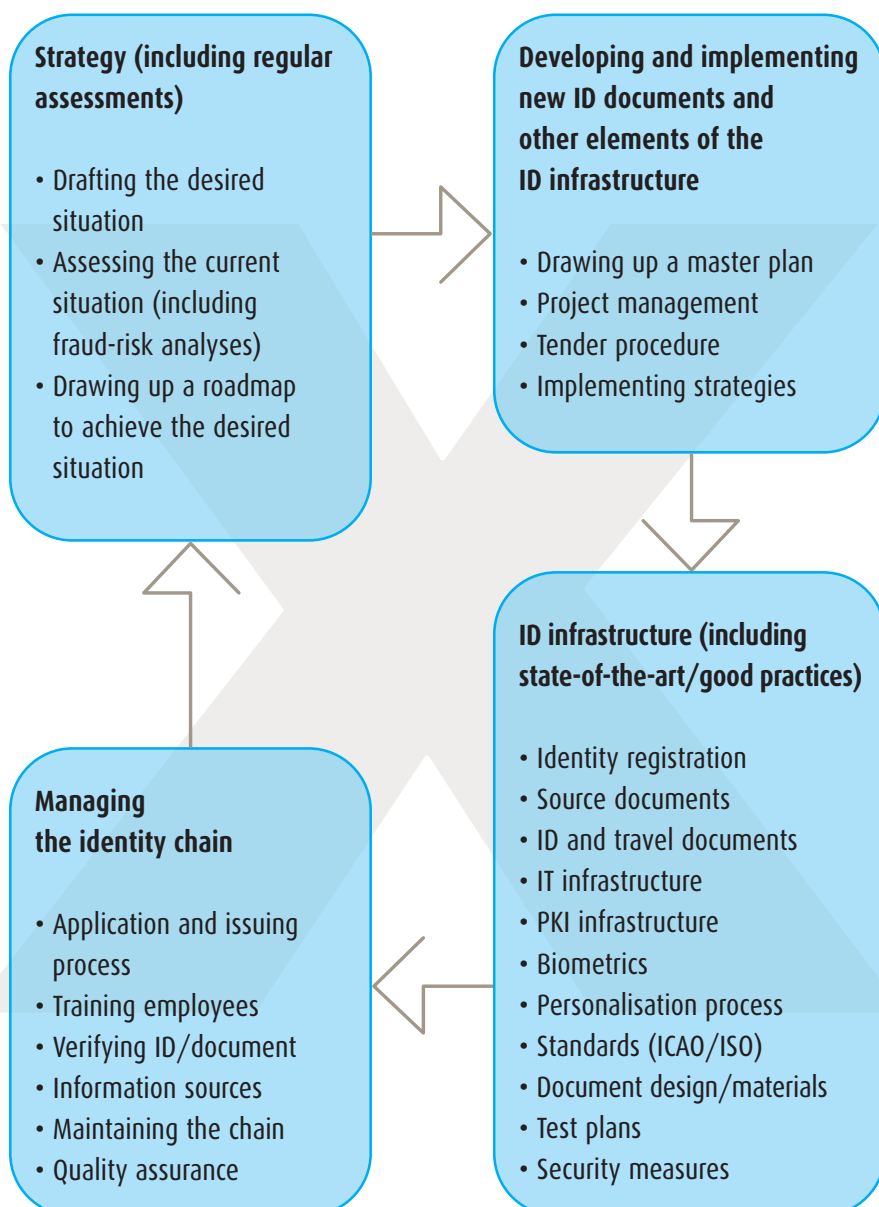


Master Class on Identity Management

Ensuring secure documents is a daily concern of governments. The current lifespan of identity documents is considerably shorter than some 20 years ago. The unrelenting threat of new forms of fraud and rapid technological development are keeping governments on their toes, forcing them to invest continuously in the field of identity management. Experience shows that it is vital that all the separate elements of the identity infrastructure be viewed and approached as parts of a unified whole. Unfortunately, this is not yet common practice among governments.

A nation's increasingly complex ID infrastructure calls for a well-defined strategy and professional management, also called Identity Management. Identity Management in the public sector is the practice of organising and managing the national ID infrastructure. It includes a wide range of components and aspects such as: a national register, source documents, identity and travel documents, IT infrastructure, biometrics, electronic identification, clear-cut and incorruptible processes and procedures, well qualified staff and quality assurance.



IDManagement Centre has developed the master class for directors, managers and CIOs who are responsible for parts of or entire governmental ID infrastructures. This Master Class on Identity Management is based on the conviction that the quality and reliability of a nation's ID infrastructure benefits strongly from professional Identity Management.
